# CLASSES & TRACKS

At New Heights Studio, we give you many choices to customize a program to align with your student's interests and goals.

## Recreational Classes

If your student wants to take a class or two or really loves just one style and not others, you can choose any class(es) from our schedule *a la carte*. Your monthly tuition will be based on the total amount of hours per week each student is enrolled. Families with more than one student enrolled will receive a 15% sibling discount.

All students will participate in our Annual Spring Recital, held June 6, 2026 at Combs Performing Arts Center.

Our season runs July 21, 2025 through June 20, 2026. New Heights Studio calculates tuition on an annual basis and divides equally among 12 months to determine our monthly pricing. Your tuition remains the same monthly, whether there are 3, 4, or 5 classes in any given month due to holidays and scheduled breaks. July tuition is the exception and will be pro-rated. Enrollment is open year-round, and students may join at any time during the season. Choose Month-to-Month enrollment or save 20% with a 12-month contract.

## PERFORMANCE TRACK

Excited to perform at special events in our community and occasionally compete against other dancers locally? Choose one or more of our performance tracks! See below for the class requirements per team and monthly tuition. These teams require an audition.

Tuition = \$119/month for the required 2 classes + rehearsals  
Two Teams = \$179/month (for the required 4 classes + rehearsals)  
(additional classes a la carte are \$30/month each)  
All teams require a 12-month commitment.

Tuition = \$239/month for Unlimited Classes (12-Month Contract)

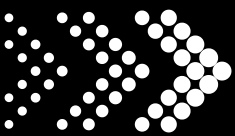

# **DANCE & CHEER PERFORMANCE TEAMS** **& DANCE COMPETITIVE ELITE TEAMS**

Students will audition and will be placed on a team according to their skill level, with the exception of the cheer team, which is open to all levels.

Dancers should audition at the same level as their Jazz class. If you are a new student or are unsure of your current level, please speak with an instructor and plan to attend a Jazz or Leaps & Turns class so that Ms. Arielle can place you accordingly before auditions.

A note on dance teams: Performance and Competitive Elite teams will combine for two group dances, with Competitive Elite teams having additional dances. Both teams will compete.

### **AGES & LEVELS**

***Elevate Cheer Team, ages 6-14, all levels***

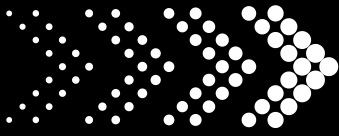
***Ascend Dance Team (Performance & Competitive Elite), Levels I/II***

***Altitude Dance Team (Performance & Competitive Elite) Levels III/IV***

**Minimum Age for all teams: Students must be 6 years old prior to audition date. *Please note, that Dance teams do not have a max age. Example, a 12 year old student may still place on a Level I/II team, if that is the skill level they are at. Students should be no older than 19 on January 1, 2026.***

## AUDITION DATES

Students must audition and understand they are making a year-long commitment to their teammates and teachers.

***Elevate Cheer Team, ages 6-14, all levels: Monday 6/16, 5:00-6:00***

*\*students should also attend a pre-tryout class on monday 6/9 @  
5:00-6:00 to learn the tryout routine*

***Ascend Dance Team, Levels I/II: Thursday 5/22, 5:45-6:45***

**Both Performance and Competitive Elite dancers will audition together.**

***Altitude Dance Team, Levels III/IV: Thursday 5/22, 7:00-8:30***

**Both Performance and Competitive Elite\* dancers will audition together.**

*(\*Competitive Elite III/IV students will need to show a 30-second self-choreographed dance, showcasing their talents. Have music ready on phone.)*

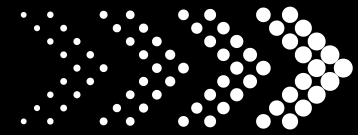
## AUDITION RESULTS



Audition results will be emailed to the parent within 72 hours of the audition. If your student makes a team, company contracts outlining the season's commitment must be signed by both the parent and student and are due to be turned into the front office staff within one week of audition results to secure their spot on the team.

### PARENT MEETING

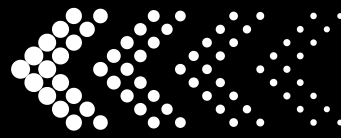
A mandatory parent meeting will be held during your student's first team rehearsal. Please review this packet and have printed/signed the contract at the end of this packet to turn in to the director.

# COST BREAKDOWN

## PERFORMANCE PACKAGE

- A \$360 Performance Package applies to each student. Students on more than one team will need to pay this for each team they are on.
- This package includes 2 group costumes (or 1 cheer uniform and 1 practice outfit), any required tights, 1 T-Shirt, all rehearsals, choreography, instructor fees, and any performance entry fee for the student.
- This package fee is non-refundable.
- This package does not include competition or convention fees, required shoes or classwear, or costumes for additional dances for Competitive Elite students.
- This package fee will be broken down into 4 installments of \$90, due 8/15, 9/15, 10/15, 11/15, paid via autopay with your card on file.

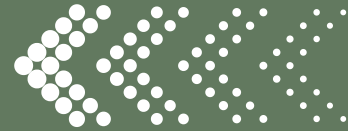
## COMPETITIONS

- Both dance teams will attend four Spring competitions locally: Spotlight Dance Cup, Beyond the Stars, D2D, Ultra Dance Tour, and Fluid (duets/solos only).
- Soloists have the option to compete at additional competitions.
- The following prices are calculated per student and may not represent every competition we attend, but is a representation of competitions we have attended in the past. These fees are for each competition:
  - \$75 per Group
  - \$90 per Duet/Trio
  - \$35 Required Photo/Video Fee
  - \$35 Director/Admin Fees per competition
  - Optional Entries for Title/Dancer of the Year (\$40) or Photogenic (\$35)
  - Does not include travel and accommodations

## CONVENTION TRAININGS FOR DANCERS

- Conventions are optional, but are highly recommended for all dancers. Competitive Elite members must attend at least two conventions.
- \$140 AXIS Dance Convention, 9/13/25 in Albuquerque, NM -or- 10/4/25 in Las Vegas, NV (ages 7+)
- ~\$260 Fluid Dance Convention, 4/24-4/26, Scottsdale, AZ (ages 6+)
- \$35 Director/Admin Fees per convention
- Does not include travel and accommodations

# COST BREAKDOWN, CONT.



## **DUET/TRIO OPPORTUNITIES**

- Students auditioning for the Competitive Elite Teams (levels I/II and III/IV) will be considered for a duet/trio.
- At the Dance Director's discretion, these opportunities are limited, and not every student will be chosen.
- Students chosen for a duet/trio will require an additional costume fee of \$90 as well as competition entry fees.

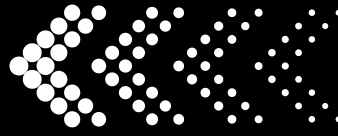
## **STUDIO WORKSHOPS & SPECIAL PROJECTS**

- In-Studio Workshops and Special Projects will be optional and announced as scheduled.
- \$40-60 per workshop

## **SOLO PACKAGE - \$550 per solo + Competition Entry Fees**

- Every dance team member has the opportunity to compete a solo, but it is optional. The Solo Package includes:
  - Personalized Choreography
  - 4 Hours Private Lessons (regular private lesson fees apply after 4 hours, if desired)
  - Solo Costume
  - Facility Rental
- Approximately \$170 Competition Entry Fee per competition
- Optional Entries for Title/Dancer of the Year (\$40)
- Students may choose to enter additional competitions to compete their solos, but must register independently and list their choreographer's name for credit.

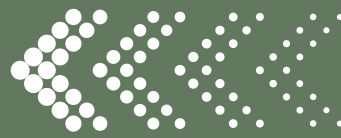
# TEAM POLICIES



## ATTENDANCE

- Teammates are expected to attend every rehearsal and required class and arrive on time, meaning 10 minutes early, shoes on, hair pulled back by start of class.
- Vacations must be scheduled so as not to interfere with rehearsals, performances, or competitions.
- All team members must obtain an 85% attendance rate for each required class, or they will be placed on probation for 21 days until they can meet the requirement. Failure to do so throughout the 21 days will be subject to removal from the team. No refunds given.
- If an injury or illness occurs, instructors must be notified immediately. Injured students are still required to attend team rehearsals and classes to watch.
- If the team member has any school or church activities that will require student to miss practice, instructors must know beforehand to be excused.
- Rehearsals within 2 weeks prior to competition and performances are mandatory. If the student misses any rehearsals during this time frame, they will be taken out of the routine for that competition/performance with no refund given.
- Sick Policy: Students who are feeling sick should plan to attend rehearsals and classes to watch unless they have a fever over 100, are vomiting or have diarrhea, or have a doctor's note. We also trust the parent knows best.

# TEAM POLICIES



## DRESS CODE

- Team members should wear all black to rehearsals, with Cheer team members wearing their practice uniform that will be ordered for them.
- Hair must be pulled back and out of the face.
- Nails must be kept shorter than fingertips. Acrylic nails are not allowed in class or competition/performances. Nail polish is not allowed at competition/performances.
- All jewelry must be removed before the start of rehearsal.
- At competition, dancers must be fully in costume by their designated meet time. This includes hair, makeup, nails, and jewelry.
- All phones will be kept in a basket by the stereo and may only be used during breaks or for filming choreography when requested by the instructor.

# FINANCIAL INVESTMENT



- All tuition is collected via Autopay with your card on file on the first of the month. A \$10 will be collected for declined payments, as well as an additional \$10 Late Fee if tuition remains unpaid by the 5th of the month.
- Any student with a balance more than 15 days late for tuition and/or other fees will be benched and expected to watch rehearsals until account is current. Any student with a balance more than 30 days late will be subject to removal from the team.
- Tuition is based on a full year and is broken into 12 monthly payments. We do not pro-rate for holidays, closures, missed practices, or vacations. However, the month of July will be pro-rated accordingly.
- If you need to leave the team mid-season, a \$200 exit fee will be assessed and automatically charged to the card on file to cover our admin and re-choreography fee for the instructor. (This fee will apply per team, if a student is on multiple teams.)
